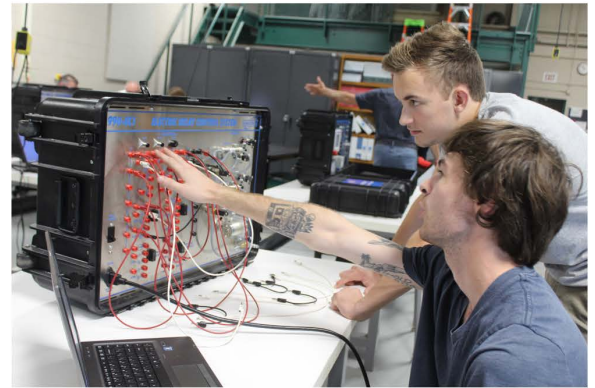




Genesee County, NY Demographics

Genesee County is located at the center of the Buffalo-Rochester Tech Corridor, home to New York's 2nd and 3rd largest metropolitans, major universities and training centers, and a highly-educated population that includes **nearly 50% of all adults 25+ having earned college degrees.**
